Can my child trial a class before enrolling?

Does my child need to attend classes regularly?

It is essential that classes are attended consistently. If students frequently miss classes, it is difficult for them to catch up on what they may have missed and it is also difficult for other students to work around those who are missing. Dancing is a team sport like any other.

What does my child bring/wear to class?

Is it compulsory to do dance exams?

Examinations are compulsory for all Jazz, Tap, Acrobatics and Classical students. Students who sit exams are selected by the teacher. Jazz, Tap & Acrobatics exams are held in the June / July holidays and Classical exams are usually held in August. Extra fees are required for exams.



KDC uniforms are custom designed and manufactured for our students. Uniforms are mandatory & can be ordered on the KDC Website along with dance shoes & stockings.

Neat buns are required for every class with black, blue, white or silver accessories.
